

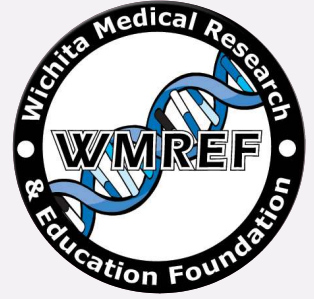
42ND ANNUAL GORE-FARHA CRITICAL CARE NURSING SYMPOSIUM
